

Idaho goods exports in 2016


Idaho's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



Exports Support Jobs

 Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Idaho Businesses


 A total of 1,816 companies exported from Idaho locations in 2014. 1,522

...and **27%** of known Idaho goods export value






Boise City is the 85th largest metro area reporting exports

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for 48% of Idaho exports
