



 Exports from Montana helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.



### Montana's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




### **Exports Support Jobs**

 Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.






### **Free Trade Agreements**

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Montana's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$811.7 million in 2016.

# In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for 60% of Montana exports



Since 2006, exports from Montana to FTA markets have grown by 42%



## Montana's Metropolitan Exports

 Great Falls is the 356th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
